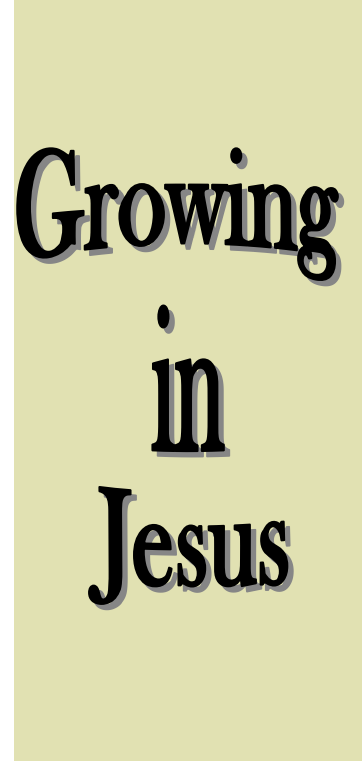
1. We are also collecting toys, warm clothing, toiletries, gift cards etc. for HomeFront
